

Park rules Buitenplaats Berg en Bos - Rental

Welcome to our park! We wish you a very pleasant stay. Our park is located directly on a beautiful nature reserve. To make your stay as pleasant as possible for everyone, including other residents and nature, we have some park rules. We kindly ask you to observe these rules.

Traffic and Parking Rules

- Please pay close attention to children playing.
- There is one-way traffic in the park.
- The speed limit in the park is 10 km per hour.
- Parking is allowed only at one's own home or in the general parking lot.
- A maximum of two cars may be parked at the homes. Additional cars and those of visitors must be placed in the parking lot near the reception.
- No caravans or campers may be parked at the residences.
- The parking lot is intended for visitors to the park.

Fire Safety, Environment, Garden Maintenance

- For fire safety reasons, open fires are not allowed on the park.
- Barbecuing is allowed except during dry periods. At the entrance to the park, it is indicated when barbecuing is not allowed.
- Limit the use of harsh detergents for toilets and sinks to protect the environment.

Respect for other residents

- Keep the volume of your radio, TV or other sound equipment such that it does not disturb other residents.
- After 10 p.m., be quiet in the park to respect the peace of other residents (and nature).
- Enter other people's plots only with permission.
- One dog is allowed per dwelling:
 - The dog must be leashed at all times, including on private property.
 - The dog must be walked outside the park and excrement must be cleaned up.

Waste

- At the parking lot there are containers for household waste:
 - The large gray container is for garbage bags; fill the front one first.
 - The large blue container is for scrap paper and cardboard; fold boxes small before throwing them away.
 - The small gray containers are for empty glass containers.
- Never place food scraps, trash or filled trash bags outside.

Playground

- Young children may play in the playground only under adult supervision.
- Older children may play in the playground with the permission of their parents/guardians.
